The Faculty of Law of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) is highly international with professors from almost twenty different jurisdictions. Our LLM students are equally international. The LLM Programmes have an alumni body from 37 countries/regions since the first cohort in 2006.

Our LLM Programmes are conducted in the CUHK Graduate Law Centre which is located in Central, the Hong Kong's central business district. For 2018-19 admission, The CUHK will offer four LLM Programmes.

LLM Global Scholarships

The Faculty seeks to assist high quality students from across the world to join our LLM Programmes through the award of scholarships. The Faculty will award three Global Scholarships to non-local students in 2018-19. Each Global Scholarship is worth up to a maximum of HK\$206,000 (approx. US\$26,400) which covers the tuition fee of HK\$126,000 (approx. US\$16,150) as well as a living stipend of HK\$80,000 (approx. US\$10,250). All applications for the LLM admission will be considered automatically for the award of the scholarship based on academic merit.
